Globally, the corporate world is undergoing significant transformation in the wake of rising focus on ESG and sustainability practices. With business stakeholders such as investors, customers, suppliers, employees and partners increasingly looking beyond financial parameters to gauge a company's performance, sustainability has become a trending topic of interest in boardroom discussions and corporate strategies. It is also becoming clear that sustainability does not merely mean regulatory compliances. It is, in fact, an opportunity to create greater business value, achieve competitive advantage, and unleash innovation.

In this context, Dun & Bradstreet India is pleased to announce the release of its premier report, 'ESG Champions of India'. The report highlights the ESG initiatives undertaken by the recipients of the 'ESG Awards 2023' and recognizes their contribution towards sustainability. Being an inaugural

edition, the Awards are the first of their kind in the industry, but have been able to garner an overwhelming response of more than 250 ESG initiatives from businesses across the country. The report also includes a listing of India's leading ESG Entities, as well as an encapsulation of the pulse and dynamics of ESG in the current scenario, along with the perspectives of various business leaders.

Sustainability no longer remains a disconnected function within an organization that used to be typically built around health/safety practises or PR or communication issues having no place in critical business decisions and strategies. Today, as we are moving towards a world where mere financial numbers no longer define corporate success, sustainability is emerging as a priority for stakeholders. The pressure on businesses to adopt sustainable practices is mounting each day, with more governments around the world committing to net-zero emissions, regulators tightening up compliances, investors flocking to companies with stronger ESG profiles, and customers and employees showing strong affinity for ESG-compliant companies. The growing focus on sustainability issues is compelling businesses to transform into social citizens and live up to the expectations, both in the letter and spirit of the mandate.

However, many companies still continue to view ESG as a compliance tool to check the right boxes, rather than adopting that ESG as a process that can help create value, spur innovation, gain competitive advantage, and help the company make a difference not just for its businesses and stakeholders but also for the environment in which it operates.

While it may seem to be a daunting task over the shortrun, ESG can also prove to be a hotbed of opportunities to refurbish a company's image in line with stakeholder expectations. Across the world, companies are inventing ways to improve their processes with a view to contribute to more pressing issues such as climate change, carbon footprint, biodiversity, human rights, gender inclusion etc. Companies such as Neste, a Finland based oil refiner, are working with other business players to build circular economies. Neste, in collaboration with fast-food chain. McDonald's, converts the latter's used cooking oil into renewable diesel, which is, in turn, utilized by supply chain company, HAVI to deliver goods back to McDonald's. The oil refiner also collaborates with local businesses to convert cooking oil, grease and other residue/ waste materials into renewable diesel to fuel the city's fleet. That is a win-win for all - plus Neste has been able to re-position itself as a sustainable player and innovator converting food waste into renewable energy.

ESG, thus, offers immense opportunities, but turning them into reality necessitates a change in mindset - right from what the company stands for and





what its core business values are; how the company aligns with the social needs, be it waste reduction, diversity, zero emissions, circular economy, etc. This would then help in defining other strategic decisions such as investments and partnerships while setting the direction on the ESG roadmap, and to create an overall narrative that the company intends to communicate to its various stakeholders.

In that context, implementing a successful ESG strategy necessitates collaborative efforts from multiple departments, and the role of corporate leaders becomes extremely important from that point of view. According to a survey conducted by Forrester for Dun & Bradstreet, 71% companies said that sustainability teams are the most important partners leading the adoption of ESG Goals. Inevitably, those in charge face the crucial and urgent task of accelerating the sustainability journey amidst rising shareholder, consumer, and regulatory pressures.

There is no doubt among business leaders that sustainability ought to be on the agenda, and MSMEs are no exception. For India to achieve its sustainability goals, it is crucial for MSMEs to embrace sustainable actions. However, a pertinent question is whether MSMEs understand the factors involved in the adoption of sustainable practices and have a clear perception of the way forward. Are they aware of the opportunities and benefits

associated with sustainability measures, and how are they bringing sustainability into practice?

With a view to answer these raging guestions, Dun and Bradstreet in collaboration with SIDBI has introduced a quarterly Sustainability Perception Index (SPeX), which is a Green Pulse Indicator to track the awareness. willingness and implementation levels of Indian MSMEs towards sustainability. The index score for October - December of 2022 is at 46, which is far less than ideal. In terms of awareness and implementation, the survey shows that there are distinct areas where MSMEs are excelling as well as lagging.

As for challenges, the biggest impediment to achieving these goals is lack of accurate, up-to-date, and transparent actionable data. According to Forrester Research, 90% of companies anticipate that ESG data will be very important to their business by 2025. These companies clearly see ESG data playing a game-changing role in an increasing number of business contexts.

However, when it comes to consistent, trustworthy, and accurate ESG data, 47% of companies do not have access to enough reliable data, and 46% believe that inconsistency or poor quality of ESG data is one of the key challenges. As a result, access to high-quality data and analysis of ESG initiatives will be the biggest competitive advantage for companies in the days to come. Dun & Bradstreet,

The social horizon has widened as the commercial landscape of the twenty-first century changed and globalisation produced businesses and marketplaces that are more integrated and dependent on one another. Social issues affect every stakeholder in a company and addressing them provides a long-term competitive edge. The quantitative and qualitative aspects of social commitments have compelled corporates to focus on ESG. While CSR continues to encourage corporations to create and carry out socially conscious initiatives in society, ESG evaluates and measures the impact of the corporate's social responsibility efforts, often in partnership with non-profits. Corporate and non-profit leaders initially saw ESG as a tool to improve the standing of their organisations among stakeholders. Since then, the focus has shifted to ESG being the tool to gauge the overall performance of a business on multiple parameters,

going beyond mere financial performance.

Understanding ESG in a Nonprofit Organization: CEOs, investors, corporations, and the social development organizations do not change overnight. But the road ahead is long and full of detours, the farsighted nonprofits have already picked up on the ESG rumblings and are positioning themselves to thrive in the new environment. The first step for most is to take a long, hard look to see how they rate on a set of parameters that, admittedly, can sometimes seem nebulous.

ESG reporting gives non-profits organisations a framework for openly discussing their work in sustainability practices. It promotes openness and enables those who support their cause and fund them to assess if the non-profit is governed well and outlines its functioning. What charities do naturally is the "S" in ESG - how non-profits deal with their constituents, including their staff, volunteers, clients, vendors, which is more inward focused.

ESG today is an imperative for non-profits to examine their operating lifecycle and work in communities. A lot of new age non-profit organisations have actively begun utilising the ESG philosophy to guarantee ongoing access to funding, as well as to increase the impact of their social objectives. And in the current context, donor retention and programmatic success will depend heavily on the incorporation of environmental and social sustainability concepts into any non-profit organisations' operating lifecycle as well as work in the community.

Non-profits are now increasingly adopting ESG for community development. Using ESG framework to further a nonprofits mission through existing and new projects will be a prerequisite. United Way in India, as a global philanthropy network, contributes to the advancement of ESG principles as an observer, proponent and practitioner. All community development projects under environment, education, health, livelihood is designed with ESG as the key focus.

An ESG lens for social development organizations to build in their community projects is a necessity now. It is not just a critical factor for funders; all stakeholders now demand changes in the way enterprises are operated and corporates and non-profits working with a united front on ESG framework can only make this happen.

Community based security of Wind Turbine Generators - An inclusive development model

SUZLON POWERING A GREENER TOMORROW

A Suzlon Case Study

Suzlon Wind Turbines are located in remote areas across different terrains and states, making them vulnerable to security breaches, which lead to significant losses in customer revenue and power generation. To ensure the sustainability of its CSR initiatives beyond project life, Suzlon has been building Village Development Committees (VDCs) and nurturing them over the years to become true representatives of the village with a deep interest and sense of service in village development.

The Challenge: In 2013 and 2014, the wind farms in Jaisalmer, Rajasthan, faced a unique challenge of theft of expensive parts of the wind turbines, particularly copper cables. Nearly INR 1.5 billion worth of material across wind farms in that area was stolen, resulting in the shutdown of nearly all wind turbines and the loss of generation and revenue thereby negatively impacting potential investment opportunities for wind energy in the state.

To address this issue, a crossfunctional think-tank at Suzlon devised multiple solutions, including increasing site security with local police and border security forces while installing CCTV cameras. However, the issue required a more inclusive and sustainable approach. An initiative of replacing copper cables with aluminium was undertaken but partnering with local communities was crucial for an immediate and permanent solution.

The Solution: This led to the creation of 'Project SUraksha', a community-based security solution implemented for 137 wind turbines across four villages in Rajasthan. A robust process was established, including selecting the village, conducting a partnership feasibility study, defining the scope of work and commercials, documentation and licensing as per the PSARA (Private Security Agency Regulation Act), and training and working with the Suzlon security teams. The impact was immediate, and the Suzlon-VDC partnership flourished since the maturity of the VDC was used as a fundamental criterion for village selection.

The Outcome: Suzlon effectively utilized the native intelligence and terrain knowledge of local villagers to combat the issue. There was a heightened sense of ownership once the villagers took charge, leading to a significant impact. VDC-based security resulted in a drastic reduction in number of thefts, early recovery of stolen materials, and less material being stolen due to early detection and response. When compared to before the implementation of VDC-based security, theft activity in VDC villages decreased by 76%.

Sustainable Impact: The agreement between the VDC and the villagers included a clause stating that a pre-decided fixed amount from their earnings

per turbine would go towards village CSR activities. Activities included providing furniture, water connections to schools, and livelihood support to widows. In Rajasthan, where water is scarce, undertaking pond deepening projects to increase water storage capacity was a priority. This initiative encouraged village women and children to contribute to the "intelligence network" by proactively reporting suspicious movements to VDCs. The VDCs in Rajasthan have invested INR 2 million in social village projects to date while significantly bringing down the incidents of theft and resultant losses.

This program aligns with SDG 8 and SDG 9, strengthening Suzlon's commitment to ESG principles. The model is being studied by various agencies as a replicable case study.

The principles of ESG (Environmental, Social, and Governance) have become extremely relevant in today's world, which is grappling with a slew of pressing social and environmental challenges. ESG considerations have become important for businesses, investors, and policymakers to ensure that growth is equitable for all people and is sustainable.

The reasons for the increasing focus on ESG are many, the most crucial one being the urgent need to address climate change. With the world getting warmer at an alarming rate, there needs to be a consensus on keeping tabs on human activities such as deforestation, burning of fossil fuels and greenhouse gas emissions. There needs to be accountability for the environmental impact of such activities and investments in clean energy and low-carbon solutions. ESG is also relevant

because of the need for social justice and inclusivity in a world where masses still live in poverty and lack access to basic rights and services despite rapid economic growth. To ensure that growth is inclusive and benefits all people; businesses, investors, and policymakers need to consider the social impact of their activities in terms of labour rights, engagement with local communities and other issues. ESG is also critical from the standpoint of ensuring good governance, sustainable and equitable growth, and preventing corruption and other forms of abuse of power at the cost of public welfare.

THE LURE OF ESG INVESTING

In recent years, ESG investing has caught the attention of many investors, to the result that the market has been flooded with an array of ESG-focused investment products, such as exchange-traded funds (ETFs) and mutual

funds. This has made it easier for investors to incorporate ESG considerations into their portfolios.

Additionally, increased investor focus on ESG has also compelled companies to adopt sustainable practices and disclose information on ESG parameters, creating, thereby, a conducive ecosystem in which investors handpick companies with strong ESG performance while companies find it rewarding to enhance their ESG performance.

With investors rising up to the trend across the globe, it has spurred regulators into formulating international ESG Standards and Guidelines, which has made it easier for investors to compare the ESG performance of different companies.

Overall, growing investor interest in environmental, social, and governance factors has, to a large





extent, propelled the emergence and evolution of ESG-based investing. As more investors likely to join the bandwagon amid rising awareness, putting ESG performance of companies under the scanner, ESG as a principle is likely to gain further push.

THE ESG TIMELINE: EMERGENCE AND EVOLUTION OF ESG

While the spirit underlying the concept of Environmental, Social, and Governance investing has been around for decades, the term has gained mainstream attention only in recent times. During the initial stages of the industrial revolution, very little attention was given to environmental and social issues. The seeds of environmental awareness and affirmative action were first sown in April 1970, when US Senator Gaylord Nelson created Earth Day to push for the inclusion of environment protection into the national agenda. The movement eventually led to the creation of the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to tackle environment-related issues.


The term "ESG" was first used in 2004, in a landmark whitepaper titled "Who Cares Wins" published by the United Nations Global Compact. The whitepaper led to the 2006 UN Principles for Responsible Investing, which laid the foundations of the ESG criteria and made a case for such criteria to be incorporated in the financial evaluation of companies. The effort was

aimed at developing sustainable investments. At that point in time, around 63 investment companies signed up with US\$ 6.5 trillion in assets under management (AUM). As of today, there are more than 4,900 signatories with AUM to the tune of around US\$ 121.3 trillion.

Later, in September 2015, the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, featuring 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), was launched by a UN Summit and adopted by all member nations. These SDGs, which provided the blueprint to achieve a better and sustainable future, included climate change, poverty, inequality, and environmental degradation as some of the key action points.

The outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic towards the end of FY20 brought on the greatest recession since World War II. Furthermore, investors dubbed it the 21st century's first sustainability crisis, a wakeup call on climate change and

a turning point in terms of a more sustainable approach to investment. The crisis gradually led to a renewed focus on ESG, by bringing to the fore the linkages of social and environmental risks and the importance of strong governance in addressing such risks. Additionally, the economic downturn caused by the pandemic led to increased scrutiny of companies' financial and operational resilience, which is closely tied to their ESG performance. The pandemic also accelerated trends towards remote work and digitalization, which have increased the importance of data privacy and cybersecurity, both of which are ESG-related issues.

Across the globe, rising corporate disclosure and investor uptake have been mainly responsible for the trend towards ESG data. According to Dun & Bradstreet ESG Ranking Report, 90% of companies on the S&P 500 published sustainability reports in 2020 compared with only 20% in 2011, while 96% of the world's largest 250 companies reported on their sustainability performance during 2020. On the investors' side, inflows of ESG assets have increased significantly, bringing in more than \$21 billion in the first quarter of 2021 alone, on track to beat the previous record of \$51 billion in 2020. Going forward, these trends are likely to accelerate given the regulatory push and overall concerns about environment and climate change.

THE INDIAN ESG ECOSYSTEM

The ESG landscape in India is complex and multifaceted, with an array of ESG challenges that need to be addressed.

These challenges include: -**Environmental concerns:** India faces significant environmental challenges, including air and water pollution, deforestation, and the impacts of climate change. Addressing these issues is critical for the health and wellbeing of the population, and for preserving natural resources for future generations. While the Indian government has taken steps to address these issues (including the implementation of stricter emission norms, investing in renewable energy resources, etc.), a lot more needs to be done to ensure that the country is on a sustainable path for the future.

Social concerns: India has a large population of people living below the poverty line, and a significant portion of the population also lacks access to basic rights and utilities. Over the years, the Indian government has implemented a number of welfare schemes and programs aimed at poverty alleviation and reduction in inequality, such as the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MNREGA) and the Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana (PMJDY). Yet there's a long way ahead to achieve inclusive growth and benefits for all people.

Governance concerns: Good governance entails processes and checks and balances to ensure prevention, detection, and action on acts of corruption and other forms of abuse of power. This is crucial in terms of ensuring growth that is sustainable and equitable. Initiatives such as the Goods and Services Tax and the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code were introduced as steps in this direction. However, more needs to be done to ensure transparency and accountability in the public and private sectors.

Investment opportunities:

With Indian companies now becoming more aware of the importance of ESG and incorporating these principles into their strategies, ESG investing is gaining significance in India. Investing on lines of ESG performance not only helps in identifying companies that are well-managed and have strong growth prospects but can also mitigate risks and capture opportunities in areas such as clean energy, water management and sustainable transportation.

India's journey in terms of business responsibility and sustainability can be traced back to a circular dated December 20, 2007, issued by the RBI, with guidelines on Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR), sustainable development and non-financial reporting and the role of banks in this regard. A couple of years later, the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) published voluntary






quidelines on CSR in 2009, which was eventually made a mandate in terms of reporting in 2012 and in terms of actual CSR spending in 2014. While the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development was launched at the UN Summit in 2015, the MCA revised its National Voluntary Guidelines (NVGs) to National Guidelines on Responsible Business Conduct (NGRBCs) in

alignment with the SDGs and the 'respect' pillar of UNGP between 2019 and 2021. In 2018. the BSE published a Guidance Document on ESG Disclosures. In 2020, this was followed up by the MCA prescribing a new format for Business Responsibility and Sustainability Report (BRSR), applicable to the top 1,000 listed companies by market capitalization, which in

2022, became a mandate for companies from FY23 onwards.

The ESG landscape in India is still developing and the standards and regulations are not yet as mature as in other countries. However, according to KPMG report released in August 2022, while all top 100 companies had furnished a business responsibility report

(BRR) as mandated by SEBI, as many as 79 also voluntarily published a standalone ESG report (with almost 90% of the companies preferring to use terminology such as sustainability report or annual integrated report). Interestingly, due to the emergence of several corporate reporting frameworks, guidance, and protocols for the purpose of ESG reporting, companies have been referring to multiple standards. Of the 79 companies that chose to voluntarily publish standalone ESG reports, about 70 referred to SDGs for the purpose of their reporting. Global Reporting Initiative (GRI), International Integrated Reporting Council (IIRC) and Task Force on Climate Related Disclosures (TFCD) frameworks were also extensively used by these companies.

However, this is about to change soon, with SEBI having made it mandatory for top 1,000 listed companies to include a Business Responsibility and Sustainability report as a part of their Annual Reports for FY23 onwards. This is not only likely to lead to a huge thrust on ESG reporting but might also lead to a shift towards the BRSR framework for the purpose of ESG reporting. Coupled with the fact that India is one of the few countries in the world to have a corporate social responsibility (CSR) mandate, this also makes India a major market for sustainability solutions and green finance, and critical to the evolution of the ESG ecosystem worldwide.

KEY ASPECTS OF ESG REPORTING

Environmental Impact:

Companies are required to provide detailed information about their environmental impact of their business activities, including greenhouse gas emissions, energy use, and waste management practices. This information can help stakeholders understand the company's impact on environment and identify areas for improvement.

Social Initiatives: Companies should also disclose information about their social initiatives, including their efforts to promote diversity, equity, and inclusion in the workplace, as well as their community engagement and acts of charity. This information can help stakeholders understand the company's commitment to social responsibility.

Governance Practices: ESG reporting also includes information about a company's governance practices, including information about its board of directors, compensation of key executives, and any potential conflicts of interest. This information can help stakeholders assess the company's commitment to transparency and ethical business practices.

Standardization: ESG reporting is a relatively new trend and there is no one single standard for reporting ESG information. Different companies may use

different metrics and reporting frameworks, making it difficult to compare performance across different companies. However, more companies are moving towards standardization, using frameworks such as the Sustainability Accounting Standards Board or the Global Reporting Initiative to report on their ESG performance.

Assurance: Assurance is the process of having independent third parties review and provide a level of assurance on the reported ESG information, which increases the credibility and reliability of the information. The assurance process is done by professional assurance providers that have the knowledge and experience to evaluate the information and provide assurance on its accuracy and completeness.

Integration with Business
Strategy: ESG reporting is not only about providing information to stakeholders, but also about integrating ESG considerations into the company's business strategy. Companies should use information provided in their ESG

strategy. Companies should use information provided in their ESG reports to identify opportunities for improvement, set goals, and track progress over time.

DECODING THE BENEFITS OF ESG REPORTING

The rising momentum of ESG is encouraging companies to increase their focus on tracking, measuring, and communicating their ESG performance.





In a study conducted by Dun & Bradstreet in collaboration with Forrester Consulting in March 2022, to evaluate the current state of ESG Data and the benefits of mature ESG strategies, it was found that the benefits of investing in ESG go well beyond avoiding fines for not complying with regulations and is a growing force driving profits through innovation and improved risk management. 81% of the 268 respondents in the survey stated their firms experienced negative consequences by failing to meet their ESG goals, with the two most common consequences being increased operational risk and increased financial risk.

Some of the benefits of ESG Reporting are enumerated below -

Improved risk management: The identification and disclosure of information on ESG risks can help companies better manage and mitigate such risks, which in turn

can help them safeguard their reputation and bottom line in the long run.

Increased access to capital: ESG reporting can help companies attract investments from socially responsible investors and other stakeholders who are looking for companies that align with their values and priorities.

Better decision-making:

Monitoring of their ESG performance can help companies gain a better understanding of their operations and identify areas for improvement. This can lead to more informed decisionmaking.

Cost savings and value creation: The implementation of sustainable practices can help companies reduce their environmental impact, optimize their energy consumption and save on costs overall. This, in turn, can lead to renewed confidence among investors.

Compliance: ESG reporting can help companies to comply with environmental and social regulations, and to demonstrate their commitment to responsible business practices. This can lead to greater freedom from regulatory pressures and less adverse risk due to government action.

Better stakeholder engagement:

Engagement on ESG issues can help build trust, understanding and better relationship with stakeholders

Enhanced reputation and brand value: Companies that generate strong track record on ESG performance can build a positive reputation and brand value, which can help to attract and retain customers, employees, and investors.

Driving collective action: At a broad level, setting ESG targets, tracking performance and disclosure thereof can

enhance the value proposition of corporates and lead to a concerted effort towards achieving global climate goals.

DRAWBACKS AND LIMITATIONS OF ESG REPORTING

While ESG reporting has become increasingly important in recent years, there are several drawbacks and limitations to consider. Some of these are -

Existence of multiple ESG frameworks: Multiple standards for ESG reporting exist. In order to meet investor demand, adequately showcase an organization's sustainability in a comparable way, and meet the criteria for ESG credit scoring, companies are forced to choose one or more frameworks to adhere to. In fact, a study by Financial Executives International, 85% of companies are currently using multiple ESG reporting frameworks.

Lack of standardization: One of the main limitations of ESG reporting is the lack of standardization in terms of what companies are expected to disclose and how they ought to disclose it. Different organizations have different reporting frameworks, guidelines, and metrics, making it difficult for companies to compare their own ESG performance with that of their peers and for investors to make meaningful comparisons between companies.

Lack of consistency: Even when companies do report on ESG issues, there can be significant variations in the type and level of information disclosed. This lack of consistency can make it difficult to compare performances across companies and sectors, making it hard for investors to make informed decisions.

Greenwashing: Some companies may use ESG reporting as a way to enhance their reputation without actually addressing the underlying issues, this is commonly known as "greenwashing". This can lead to a lack of trust in ESG reporting and make it difficult for investors to identify companies that are truly committed to sustainability.

Reliability of data and complex **ESG** data management: ESG data is often self-reported by companies, which means that it may not be fully reliable or accurate. This lack of independent verification can limit the value of ESG reporting for investors and other stakeholders. Also, the fact that sustainability is hard to quantify makes data collection a challenge. Furthermore, since ESG data is often divided in siloes, a global, integrated view is hard to generate. The lack of a centralized source of financial and sustainability data makes it impossible to establish a link between ESG action and financial outcomes.

Limited comparability: Even when companies disclose similar data, it may be difficult to compare due to the lack of standardization and the use of different metrics.

FACTORS HINDERING ESG ADOPTION IN INDIA

There are several factors that are hindering ESG and sustainable development in India, including -

Lack of government regulation:

Although the CSR policy and BRSR norms are in place, these apply to a select set of companies only. India therefore lacks a comprehensive framework for ESG and sustainable development, and there is little government regulation in place to encourage the larger universe of companies to adopt sustainable practices.

Limited awareness and understanding: Many companies in India lack awareness and understanding of ESG and sustainable development issues, which makes it difficult for them to take action to address these issues.

Limited financial resources: Small and medium-sized enterprises in particular have limited financial resources at their disposal, which severely constrains their ability to invest in sustainable practices and technologies.

Limited access to capital and technology: Limited access to capital and technology (which is a





reality for most MSMEs) can make it difficult for companies to scale up their operations and grow their businesses, thereby placing ESG under their lowest priorities.

Limited access to information and expertise: Many companies in India lack access to information and expertise on sustainable practices and technologies, which can make it difficult for them to take action to address ESG and sustainable development issues.

All of these factors combined, make it difficult for companies in India to adopt sustainable practices and technologies, and to make meaningful progress on ESG and sustainable development issues. However, with increasing awareness and understanding of ESG and sustainable development, and growing pressure from investors, customers, and other stakeholders, it is likely that we will see more companies in India begin to act on these issues in the future.

ROADMAP TO ENHANCE ESG REPORTING

ESG reporting can be improved through the following action points -

Standardization of ESG reporting frameworks: At present, there exist multiple reporting frameworks, having varying reporting guidelines and metrics. Standardizing ESG reporting frameworks can help ensure

that companies are consistently reporting on their ESG performance and sustainability efforts in a way that is meaningful and easily comparable with other companies.

Improved data quality and transparency: Enhancing the quality and transparency of ESG data can help ensure that companies are accurately reporting on their ESG performance and sustainability efforts, and build trust in ESG reporting among investors, customers, and other stakeholders. In fact, 90% of the 268 respondents in the aforementioned survey conducted by D&B and Forrester Consulting said that they expect ESG data to be a critical asset to their companies by 2025.

Integration of ESG data into financial reporting: The integration of ESG data into financial reporting can help ensure that companies are taking ESG and sustainability considerations into account in their business operations and decision-making processes and can lead to more alignment between ESG and financial performance, which is certainly the need of the hour.

Increased stakeholder engagement: Encouraging companies to engage more actively with their stakeholders on ESG and sustainability issues will not only ensure that companies take these issues into account in their business

operations and decision-making processes but will also help build trust in ESG reporting.

Increased investment in ESG and sustainability technologies:

Encouraging companies to invest in ESG and sustainability technologies can help to ensure that they are adopting sustainable practices and technologies and can help to ensure that they are making meaningful progress on ESG and sustainability issues.

Stringent government regulations and incentives:

While ESG reporting and regulations pertaining to the same is currently voluntary for the larger universe of companies (except for top 1,000 companies), stringent and elaborate government regulation and incentives can lead to better compliance by businesses at large and encourage the adoption of sustainable practices and technologies...

- f. To prevent greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions from food waste, we installed a compost system. ~2000kgs of food waste has been converted to compost to date, which is used in our on-site green gardens/green walls and open green spaces.
- g. With a focus on the 3R principle and promoting awareness regarding recycling and sustainability, we installed a Reverse vending machine (RVM). ~90kgs of plastic waste has been recycled till date.
- h. ASC Launched employee verse in 2023 which is a digital platform to ideate, collaborate, engage and convert ideas into innovation through PoC's.
- i. We prioritize employee wellbeing and mental wellness initiatives.
- j. DE&I is a strategic pillar of our strategy, and we are

committed to elevate diversability in leadership roles.



WHAT DOES ESG MEAN IN THE CURRENT SCENARIO, AND WHAT ESG INITIATIVES YOUR COMPANY HAS TAKEN IN PAST 2 YEARS?

ESG is one of the pivotal and forward-looking initiative run by GE HealthCare to reduce Greenhouse Gas (GHG) and make an impact on society through Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) driving purpose behind this priority.

With the growing threat of climate change, systemic inequality, and global health disparities, we recognize that fulfilling our purpose, and following through on our commitments, has never been more essential. We are making operational investments in energy efficient equipment, reducing emissions from the grid through smart green power sourcing and using lean practices to eliminate energy waste. We set out on this journey in 2019, with goal of net zero by 2050. GE BEL has been leading the efforts on ESG through a string of focused efforts.

 98% of GE BEL's 20GWh annual power consumption is solar, reducing 10,453 tCO2e through solar PPA, along a complete inhouse solar power driving savings 60MWh/ Month. Value stream map (VSM) is a lean methodology used to analyze flow of material and design a future state. At our factory, we have leveraged this to create Green-VSM and identified projects focusing on energy, material, water and garbage reduction along with Air to Ocean(A20) shipment, Packing Boxes optimization, Parts Harvesting - CAN (Certified as New) program. All this has helped achieve electricity reduction by 18%, and waste elimination of 1.9 Ton/Year.

HOW DOES GE HEALTHCARE ENGAGE WITH ITS STAKEHOLDERS (I.E., CUSTOMER, EMPLOYEES) TO IMPLEMENT ESG INTO PRACTICE?

At GE HealthCare, sustainability goals are driven at the grassroots by our passionate colleagues who are empowered to drive change. We also have a strong priority flow down within the organization, making a visible leadership commitment and driving accountability. We engage in employee involved programs throughout the year enabling heightened awareness & sensitivity with programs such Green Kaizen activity driven by our shopfloor team, Over 35,000 sapling plantation & maintenance as a CSR initiative in the metro

piers. In addition, we celebrate Earth Day with handmade 10,000 seedballs distributing to local parks, and ran a 30 acre Kundalahalli lake restoration program in partnership with United Way and BBMP - the local government body as part of CSR.

GE HealthCare's is commitment to cut 50% of scope-1 direct emissions and scope2 energy emissions by 2030 has set actions in motion to reduce and reach the goal of net zero by 2050.

HOW DOES GE HEALTHCARE PLANS TO CONTINUE TO ACHIEVE ITS ESG GROWTH OBJECTIVES?

We believe culturally engraining the purpose of ESG is very critical to continue and sustain this vision. We leverage people ideas, kaizens and lean methodologies of waste elimination to add speed and direction. Sustainability is also part of our EHS framework helping us keep up to regulations and standards making us pivot to dynamic needs. We bring focus through active trending of KPI in daily management systems, also have shark tank funded projects, enabling ESG ideas become reality. Engaged colleagues and focused strategies to reduce GHG releases is helping us provide ecofriendly and environmental conscious design and technical solutions.

Company's ESG initiatives and its impact:

- Energy & Carbon: The company has added more green buildings, installed roof top solar PVs across campuses. The company has reduced the scope 1 + 2 emissions by 66% in FY22 against base year FY16. Total on-site roof top solar capacity across owned campuses is 10.2 MWp and the total electricity generated from in-house solar plants is 11.3 million units which contributed to 3.76% of total electricity use in the reporting year.
- Water: The company consumed 1.44 bn liters of fresh water in FY22. Whereas 5.2% of water from RWH, 86.4 % from third party sources and the remaining 8.4% from ground water.

- Biodiversity: The company has effectively implemented TCS Biodiversity Program, which resulted in supporting 593 species of flora and 183 species of fauna as well as 39,276 well grown trees within the TCS campuses.
- Certification: ISO 9001:2015 (Quality Management), ISO 20000:2018 (IT Service Management), ISO 22301:2019 (Business Continuity Management), ISO 27001:2013 (Information Security Management) and compliance to ISO 27017:2015 (Information Security Controls for Cloud Services), ISO 27018:2019 (Protection of PII in Public Clouds as PII Processors) and ISO 27701:2019 (Privacy Information Management Systems).

- Climate Initiative: The Dholakia Foundation has committed to conserve and improve the natural resources with an ambitious goal and a noble effort of over 25 lakh tree plantations, including raising them and developing 109 lakes (Sarovar) under Mission100 Sarovar in various parts of Gujarat and in different regions of India. The company foundation has created 110 lakes (Sarovars) under our #Mission100Sarovar in Saurashtra, Southern Gujarat, and different regions of India starting in 2008. The surface water bodies constructed under the mission100sarovar have aided in increased groundwater recharge, which was evident from the high water table from 15-20 wells within the 500m range and 10-20 wells within the 500-1000m range of water resource structures.
- Biodiversity Initiative: The company has increased green cover in the areas surrounding it by up to 18 km and introduced new varieties of plants. It has also improved soil quality with a significant reduction in salinity. Furthermore, the initiative

- has resulted in a 50% increase in groundnut and cotton crop productivity, as well as a more than 50% increase in Kharif Pearl Millet productivity.
- Water Initiative: Water is available around the year, not only for domestic use but also for irrigation. Water quality improved from 1500 TDS to 450-500 TDS and continues to improve year after year. The groundwater level has improved significantly and is now at 30 feet, compared to 500 feet a few years ago. In villages like Vandlia, Akala, and Shekh Pipaliya, there has been a 30-40% reduction in TDS from 1100-1800 ppm to 900-1300 ppm during winters due to water retaining structures. There has been a drastic fall in TDS in wells in Dudhala and Devaliya villages from 3500 ppm to 2200-2500 ppm.

Further, in-house water recycling systems are installed at campuses which recycle 40% of total water consumption. Additionally, the company has partnered with Smart Energy Water (SEW) to accelerate digital transformation for the energy and water utility industry.




